- 1. Call to Order
- 2. Follow up: Pancake day went very well. The next Kernels fundraising date is to be set after today's meeting.
- 3. Principles Report:
  - a. Accommodation Review for Peterborough and Peterborough County
    - i. 4 scenarios
    - ii. 1 of the scenarios would change Chemong to be a feeder school for Crestwood
    - iii. April 17<sup>th</sup> parents are welcome to gather for information and feedback
    - iv. All scenarios are listed on the boar website
    - v. Final decisions will be made in December 2024 or January 2025
    - vi. All schools will be asked to put a hold on out of boundary students
  - b. Official Retirement of Margaret Adkins
  - c. EQAO will be written May 21-24 for grade 3 and 6
  - d. Earth Day is April 22<sup>nd</sup>. A few student council members signed up to help put together a presentation for the school. It will be presented to each division.
